



New Community Center in Crowley Lake

The new Crowley Lake Community Center is almost open. A beautiful new building has gone up with only a few minor hitches and should be ready for community use by August. The center, funded mostly by taxes from the **Geothermal plant**, has a large, open floor plan, which can be divided for multiple-use, big kitchen, bathrooms, stage area and gorgeous views of the Sierra Crest to the south and west. The grounds are to be simply landscaped with drought-tolerant plants and trees, and will have an automatic watering system. Organizers hope to schedule some weekends of volunteer-help with plantings.

A grand-opening party is planned tentatively for late August. Please look for future posters and postings for more details. We, of the Mono County Service Area Number One Board, hope you will come and enjoy the new center and start planning activities for its use. LM
